Demba's grandfather, Malick Diop, was a visionary who donated his own land to found the very first school in Thiaroye-sur-Mer. He believed that education was the foundation of a strong community. Today, Demba continues that legacy of learning by providing essential funds for maintenance, desks, and supplies, ensuring the children have a safe environment to study and thrive.

Protecting the Community

During the rainy season, the village lacks natural drainage, which often results in devastating floods that reach the school and the local cemetery. Demba personally led a project with local young men to design and build a manual drainage system. Your support helps maintain this vital infrastructure, protecting the streets and the dignity of the village.

Vital Medical Support

Access to healthcare is a critical challenge in rural Senegal. The fund provides essential financial support to local medical staff and the village clinic. These donations help bridge the gap in resources, ensuring that medicine, basic healthcare, and emergency assistance are available to the families who need them most.

Agricultural Independence

Sustainability means giving people the tools to thrive at home. Demba supports local women in establishing their own agricultural projects, such as poultry farming. These initiatives allow mothers to create independent businesses, providing a reliable source of income and long-term financial security for their families.

Just as the Ospreys migrate from our Highland lochs to the shores of West Africa each autumn, Demba bridges the gap between our two coastal homes.
